The company presently grows Wolf Fish for market consumption and will be moving its Wolf Fish brood to Victoria, PEI. The Victoria operation houses all the captive broodstock Halibut in North America and uses RAS technology to rear Halibut larvae to market sized fish. The company plans to produce both Halibut and Wolf Fish for the marketplace while focussing on environmentally sustainable on land fish farming practices.

- Inspecting, repairing, rebuilding, or replacing various pumps, gear reducers & drives, motors, shaft seals, bearings, and mechanical seals
- Installing of process & utility equipment (electrical/mechanical /instrumentation/plumbing)
- Analytical troubleshooting, detecting irregularities in equipment, and repairing mechanical & electrical related breakdowns identifying the root cause, and addressing the problem effectively
- Becoming sufficiently familiar with the operation of all plant equipment in order to identify irregularities and provide quick and innovative solutions to equipment and process issues
- Utilizing knowledge and skill to recognize opportunities for improvement and savings
- Maintaining a preventative maintenance program for facility equipment and keeping detailed records of maintenance including equipment manuals, repair histories and spare parts inventories
